
### From Brother Mike...

I heard a question a few days ago that made me stop and think. It was "What have you learned in the Bible this week?" The reason it made me think was my suspicion about how many of us would answer that. Do we really work to learn new things from Scripture? I ask this especially of those of us who have been Christians for a number of years. We can read the Bible regularly. We may attend Sunday School almost every Sunday. If he had a question that he couldn't figure out, it usually was one I couldn't answer off the top of my head, either. I appreciated the questions after they were dealt with because it made me study more and I was encouraged that he was digging in as well.
