

#### From Brother Mike...

We live in a day and time where it seems everything is turned into a crisis. Yes, we just made it through a major winter storm. And we can be sure another storm will come one day.

In the church world we have several points of crisis proportions. We have heard the past few years that we are facing a shortage of pastors. As many of them reach retirement there are not as many young men coming into the pastoral ministry. We are also facing a lack of pianists, organists and music leaders. These things are having a direct impact on many of our churches and the problem is likely to grow in time.


In talking to pastors and churches, one of the things I have concluded is that we face a general apathy about serving in the church. I am not talking just about pastors and music leaders. Many churches are struggling to find volunteers to serve. There seems to be a general characteristic of many church volunteers today: they have gray hair. As the boomer generation reaches a point of being unable to serve or receiving our heavenly reward, what is going to happen?

If you are a Christian, you have been given at least one spiritual gift by God. Are you using your gift? Over my years of ministry, I have encountered numerous believers who had no clue what their gift was or what to do with it. Gifts are given by God to minister in and to the church body. I encourage all church members to find your gift and learn how to use it for the benefit of the church.

We are facing decisions in the association in regards to volunteers. Christian Builders has been a very active group and are in high demand in our community. They have averaged building around 35 ramps a year for the past several years. Yet, we are facing the reality of having to turn people down because we do not have enough people to serve. Four people cannot build 35 ramps this year. Scott Duckworth is stepping down as the coordinator because of all the time required as a Fire Department Chaplin. We are asking for someone to step up and fill this role and others who can step up and help get the work done.

The decision we and the churches now face is will this ministry continue? Without volunteers, many of our ministries will cease to exist.

My prayer is that God will call and encourage His people to live out their faith. Will you join me in that prayer?
