From Rachel Lovingood, the Bible Study Leader, to one of the break-out conference leaders, Gordon Fort, the Senior Ambassador for the President of the International Mission Board, telling how God is working around the world. One example -Cuba: challenging, encouraging and getting out of one's comfort zone are just a few descriptive words describing this weekend and it was all about JESUS. Next year the date is March 16-18, 2018. It will be here before you know it. City Reach Knoxville benefitted from 1900 full-size toiletries plus gift cards for various ministry sites across Knoxville and surrounding areas. What a tangible way to open the door to tell that Jesus loves you and I do too. Another great way we at the MGT are getting to partner with the 2017 Missionary Kids (MK) Re-Entry Retreat being hosted for the first time by Tennessee WMU. 
