#### From Brother Mike...

What a blessing it is to see so many "normal" church activities arriving on the schedule now. It has been a long, difficult year. I pray we have a greater appreciation for these normal activities.

My question now is this, "what have we learned from the past year?"

We should have learned the truth that God did not make us to be isolated individuals. We were created for fellowship with God and one another. If you understand the first few chapters of Genesis you know God created mankind in his image. Communion with our Creator is an important part of who we are. I expect it will make a difference in your life. Let's work to make strengthen one another in the faith.
